It is the intention of the BCCS to provide the means whereby the tradition of Celtic heritage can be passed on to future generations.



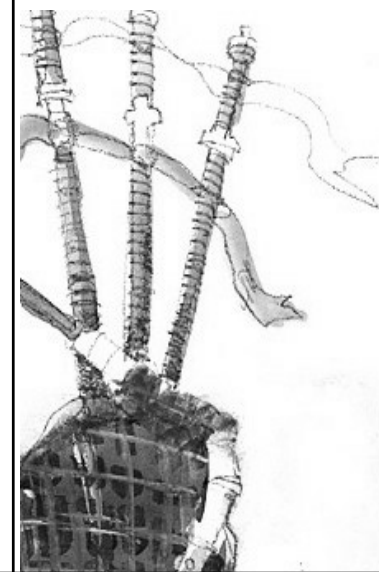
